## Live Music Performance Duration (Sets)

## Wedding Dinner / Luncheon Reception

1. Band's Set 1 shall not exceed 1.0 hour ( 15 songs at max) in total.
2. Set 1 can be separated into Set 1 a and Set 1 b by inserting agendas in between such as speeches or video presentation. In such planning, lesser songs are to be prepared for Set 1 in total.
3. Band's Set 2 shall not exceed 45 minutes ( 10 songs at max including encore songs).
4. Set 2 comprises of 3 parts: the first 3 songs (insert your first-dance here), non-stop dance music, the last 4 songs (bid-goodbye).
5. If your agendas are dragged beyond buffer-time, then Set 2 are going to be cut short.

## Corporate Function / Gala Dinners

1. Ideally, the band's Set 1 is 45 minutes ( 10 songs) and Set 2 to be 30 minutes ( 7 songs).
2. If the itinerary has lesser time allocated for the band's performance, then Set 1 is to be having 30 minutes (7 songs) minimally.
3. If the itinerary has lesser time allocated for the band's performance, then Set 2 is to be having 18 minutes (4 songs) minimally.
4. Alternatively, the band could also perform in 3 sets i.e. $(30+30+15)$ minutes - provided there are not many agendas.

## Wedding (Garden) Ceremony

1. The Prelude is to last for 15 minutes only - estimated 4 to 5 songs (it's played just before the Processional March)
2. Processional music (bridal party march-in, and father-bride march-in) - 2 songs
3. Recessional music (march-out) - 1 song
4. Post-ceremony is to last for 30 minutes, covering about 7 to 8 songs (during balloon-release, photography, bouquet-tossing, etc.)
