

The Emcee's Role In General

- A spokesperson representing the hosts (families/organization)
- Come in proper dressing & mannerism (bodily movements, hand gestures & overall posture)
- Making sure the flow of the wedding itinerary is followed accordingly
- Smoothen the continuity before-and-after each item, keeping everyone well informed
- Presenting the bride & groom during the march-in(s)
- Giving a warm and welcoming short speech to the guests during the opening
- Clear & articulate announcements of agendas (food presentation, slide presentations, etc.)
- Inviting the speaker(s) for speeches with an introductory note (name, status, relation)
- Hosting the cake-cutting & champagne pouring ceremony (with sweet phrases)
- Inviting families members for the 'yam-seng' ceremony and hosting the session
- Thanking the guests for their presence with a closing note (during the last song)
- Building up the audience's mood by fetching applauses (preventing awkward silence)
- Calming down the audience when there's any technical issues or emergencies
- Every attendees' experience is mainly affected by the emcee
